

## Conflict Minerals Certificate of Compliance

Paragon Controls Inc. designs and manufactures airflow and pressure sensing elements and transducers for clients worldwide in the commercial ventilation, laboratory, healthcare, pharmaceutical, power, semiconductor, wastewater treatment, and various other light and heavy industrial markets.

This document certifies that Paragon Controls Inc. products listed below conform to the requirements of the Dodd-Frank Act, Section 1502, which requires companies to disclose their use of conflict minerals if those minerals are “necessary to the functionality or production of a product”. Under the Act, those minerals include tin, tantalum, tungsten, or gold taken from the conflict region defined as the Democratic Republic of Congo and adjoining countries.

Based on the material declarations from the component manufacturers, tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold are contained in a few of our products however as part of our reasonable due diligence Paragon Controls Inc. has contacted our suppliers to verify their continued compliance with the regulation in which they require their direct suppliers to be conflict-free. Therefore, Paragon Controls, Inc. does not knowingly supply products containing minerals from the conflict region.
